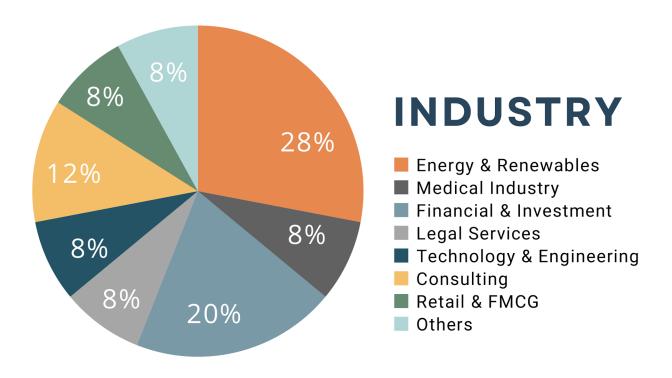

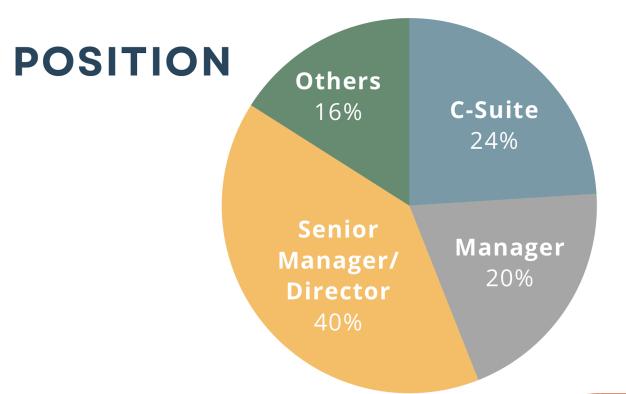
BCCTaipei eagerly anticipates running the programme again in 2024 and aims to broaden its scope once more.

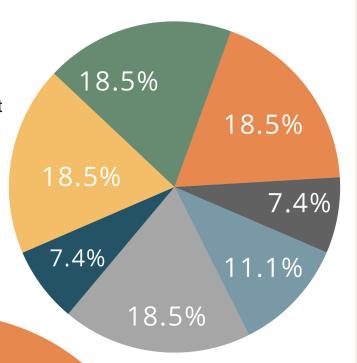

### The greatest challenges during the programme

- Matching busy schedules with both mentor and mentee.
- Facing cultural and language differences.
- Encountering motivational hurdles, which impact the engagement and success of the mentorship programme.



### **Suggestions**

- Establish regular touchpoints to ensure the effectiveness of the mentor/mentee relationship.
- Choose participants with genuine interest and time commitment for a more fulfilling and effective mentorship programme.
- Implement regular feedback sessions to assess the effectiveness of the mentorship programme.
